Subject: Grayhill Series 39: RoHS Compliance Information

In order to comply with the Restriction on Hazardous Substances directive Grayhill, Inc. is removing cadmium from our Series 39 switches. Most components had a bushing or hex nut plated in cadmium. This has been replaced with a zinc trivalent chromate finish. The new products will be free of any restricted substances and will be compatible with existing tin/lead processes as well as lead-free processes.

The part numbers will not change. Grayhill, Inc. will be making a running change. As inventories of non-compliant parts are depleted, they will no longer be available and compliant parts will become standard. All parts manufactured after April 1, 2006 with EIA date code 0614 will be compliant. Shipping boxes and packing slips will be labeled or marked with a lead-free compliance marking per JESD97 and an "RoHS Compliant" tag.
